This amendment is divided into a chronological record of the research project to date, followed by a chronological listing of feasible targets for the upcoming period, a statement of the expected outcome of the study, and statements of anticipated activities during the next research period (RP II and III). Please remember that all candidates are expected to submit their results for publication during their Ph.D. studies.
