12th International Academic Teacher Training Course for Health Professions From 22nd to 26th of February 2021 ONLINE

Application Deadline: 01 December 2020

Background

Professionalization of medical education and capacity building for health professions are key factors for a sustainable development of health care systems worldwide.

The International Academic Teacher Training Course for Health Professions (ATTC) in Munich makes use of the excellence in faculty development of the medical faculty of LMU Munich to support the development of globally applicable approaches in medical education. This activity has been carried out by the CIH^{LMU} and the Institute for Medical Education and is embedded in a strong network with partner institutions that has existed for over 20 years.

Target Group

The workshop is designed to bring together staff in health professions education who want to improve their skills as an educator, and health educators with responsibility for the medical curriculum.

Teaching Methods

The course aims to initiate an active and participatory learning process by using constructive and interactive learning methods and concepts. The development of related competencies (including intercultural and softs skills) are supported by facilitated small group discussions, group work, independent study, individual and group presentations and expert sessions.

Learning content

In the course, the participants will:

- Structure the teaching and learning in large and small classes
- perform curriculum development from learning objectives to assessment methods and teaching and learning activities
- giving and receiving feedback to peers and students in their daily practice
- get aware of requirements for intercultural communication and collaborations
- share professional teaching expertise across different health professions and countries
- use online facilitation tools and techniques to handle the requirements of the pandemic

Participants have ...

- English language proficiency at C1 level
- Previous experience in teaching students from health professions or health workers
- a work environment to practice newly acquired teaching skills during the transfer phase

Duration/ Certification

- 5-days synchronous e-learning course (35 hours) from the 22nd to 26th of February 2021 plus kick-off meeting (13th of February 2021 from 10:00 to 14:30 CET) plus transfer phase (16th of July 2021 from 09:00 to 13:00 CEST) plus approximately 8 hours of per-course assignments. Fulltime attendance is required.
- Participants receives a preliminary certificate of attendance after the completion of kick-off and 5-days course. Participants receive the final certificate upon successful completion of the transfer phase assignment,
- Please, check synchronous and asynchronous sessions of the course in your own time zone
- A successful completion of the training is credited with 3 ECTS points.



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Course Fees

The tuition fee includes online facilitation only.
