## Your Area of Work:

The team assistant is responsible in the Teaching & Training Unit of the Tropical Institute for the administration and support of the tropEd Network for International Health (www.troped.org), a worldwide network of 25 universities that offer courses in the field of International Health. This involves communication within the network, maintenance of the website and the course database, planning and implementation of the General Assemblies, which take place three times a year, each lasting 3 days (once online and twice in presence; and once every two years outside Europe). Willingness to travel is hence expected. In addition, the Team Assistant is responsible for several symposia that take place in Munich (e.g. Humanitarian Symposium Munich; Saturday all day), with auditorium booking, participant management, speaker management, budget planning. The part-time position is classified in group E6 according to TV-L and is set at 50% (working days Tuesday to Friday).
