The research assistant for the project "Knowledge, attitudes, and practices towards the risk of zoonotic diseases, wildlife trade, and wildlife consumption in Latin America" ("KAP-Study wildlife") is expected to be an active participant in the research process. This involves activities related to literature review, synthesis and analysis of collected information, as well as coordination of field activities for the development and implementation of educational strategies. Additionally, the assistant should coordinate activities with key stakeholders in the region associated with the subject matter. The position offers the opportunity to be part of an international research team, providing experience in both research and interdisciplinary work. The role is expected to involve tasks with a high level of commitment.

2. Task description

- Review and synthesis of literature on the subject in Chile
- Synthesis and analysis of the collected information (especially the qualitative component of the project)
- Coordinator for the design and on-site implementation of the educational interventions of the project
- On-site coordination with local stakeholders
- Support in administrative management

Starting from March 11, 2024, for a period of 5 months (Approximately 20 hours per week workload is considered).
